



Auction Instructions

1. Don't forget to bring your 'stuff' from home!
2. On arrival at the venue, bring your 'stuff' and place it on the tables in the main hall. You **DO NOT** need to have lot numbers. Please keep all your 'stuff' together and place a name label with it. (Labels available from Gillie Slater)
3. If you intend to bid, please see Gillie to get a Bidding Number (and even if you don't INTEND to bid get a number anyway because you look a right plonker when you suddenly find yourself holding up proceedings mid-auction because you want to bid on something!)
4. At the allotted time the Auction will proceed much along the lines of any other auction as performed by Sotherby's or Bonhams (but the bids may be a slightly lower!): The Auctioneer will describe the lot being sold and if you wish to bid you hold up your Bidder Number.
5. At the fall of the hammer please make sure that the Tellers can see your Bidder Number if you have won that item.
6. At the end of the Auction please come to the Tellers table and settle your account in **cash** – we can't take cards or cheques.
7. If you are a Vendor, please wait for the winning Bidders to settle their accounts before coming to the Tellers to collect your proceeds.
8. Take all your new-found treasures home!
