## **EXETER REGATTA, Aug. 14 & 15 1982**

Exeter Maritime Museum are our hosts for this event which will form part of a Steam Fortnight held as part of Maritime Heritage Year. The Museum is in the heart of the City of Exeter at the head of the Exeter Ship Canal. Excellent facilities will be available for mooring boats at the Museum, where launching will be carried out by crane, there is no suitable slipway. Fuel can be made available, if requested in advance. No licence is required for the Canal and all charges will be met by Exeter Maritime Museum.

Caravans may be parked on the museum grounds and hotel and guest house accomodation is excellent in Exeter. A first class camp site is situated just out side the City, but you are advised to book early as it is very busy at this time of year.

The regatta will be based on the Canal and on the Saturday it is intended to steam to Turf Locks for a picnic, boats may wish to go out on the tideway, the lock may be opened if this is known in advance. A Barbecue will be held at the Museum on the Saturday evening.

On the Sunday a cruise to Double locks for a picnic lunch on the banks of the canal and return to the museum where some may wish to enter the river, if the water level is suitable, and explore a little way upstream before being craned out.

The museum will have its steam exhibits on show and it is hoped insteam during the week end.

Full details of how to find the Museum and the best way to leave the M5 will be given upon receipt of the application forms.
